CINAHL: Cumulative Index to Nursing & Allied Health Literature

Online Library Database

CINAHL provides indexing and abstracting for over 1,600 current nursing and allied health journals and publications dating back to 1982 and contains over 700,000 records. Covers nursing, biomedicine, health sciences librarianship, alternative/complementary medicine, consumer health and 17 allied health disciplines, providing access to full text for 56 journals plus legal cases, clinical innovations, critical paths, drug records, research instruments, clinical trials, 1982 - present.

Contains magazines, journals, newspapers, definitions, directories, and information on: Fitness, Pregnancy, Medicine, Nutrition, Diseases, Public Health, Occupational Health and Safety, Alcohol and Drug abuse, Prescription Drugs, Herbal remedies, and alternative or complementary treatments, 1980 - present.

MEDLINE, a service of the National Library of Medicine, provides access to over 12 million citations back to the mid-1960's and additional life science journals. Includes links to many sites providing full text articles and other related resources.

PsycINFO

Online Library Database

PsycINFO contains citations and summaries of journal articles, book chapters, books, dissertations, and technical reports, all in the field of psychology and the psychological aspects of related disciplines, such as medicine, psychiatry, nursing, sociology, education, pharmacology, physiology, linguistics, anthropology, business, and law, 1887 - present.
