Requirements:

- Cumulative GPA of at least 2.50
Dolan School of Business students seeking academic credit for their first internship must pursue it in their business major.
Dolan School of Business students may pursue a second internship for credit in their business major or business minor.

Guidelines:

- You may elect to intern for one or two semesters or during the summer.
You may earn from three to six credits in internships.
You will receive supervision by a faculty member, on-site mentors, and the director of internships.
