

Extension of Stay Request

If you will not be able to complete your program of study before the “program end date” on your Form I-20 you will then need to apply for an extension of stay. However, extensions of stay will only be granted to those who are eligible for that benefit.

ELIGIBILITY

- You must have continually maintained your status.
- You must be able to prove that there are valid academic reasons for going beyond the time limit on your initial I-20. **Please note that delays caused by academic probation or suspension are not acceptable reasons for program extension.**

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Complete all the information below. **You will need to come up with a new program end date with your academic advisor or dean.**
- Provide all supporting documents as demanded by the Office of International Students.
- Receive and sign new Form I-20 reflecting the new program end date.
