GRADUATE STUDENT OUTCOMES REPORT

This report is a summary of the graduate student destination survey distributed to the students graduating in August 2023, January 2024 and May 2024.

The report is based upon the knowledge rate* of 69 percent of the class. Information was collected from the graduate students, employer reports and other employment resources. 99.3 percent of the population reported employment and 0.7 percent reported pursuing additional education. Of the graduated students that responded:

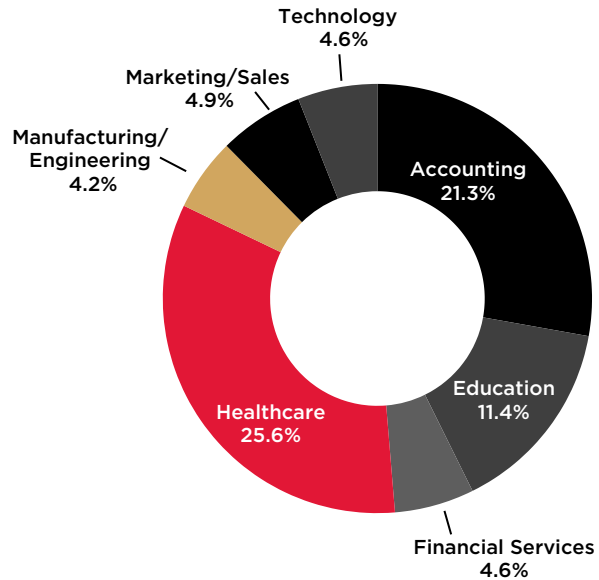

Reported that their degree has put them on the right path to obtaining their career goals

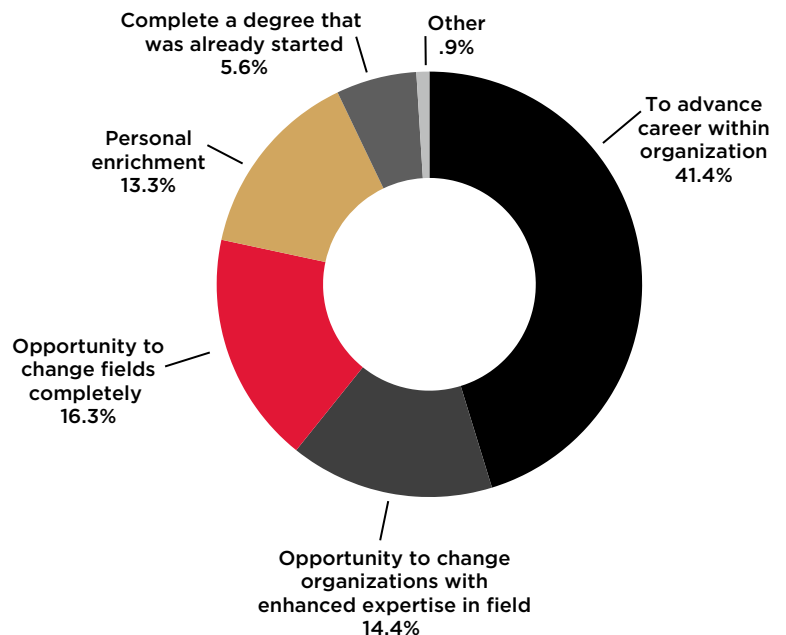
