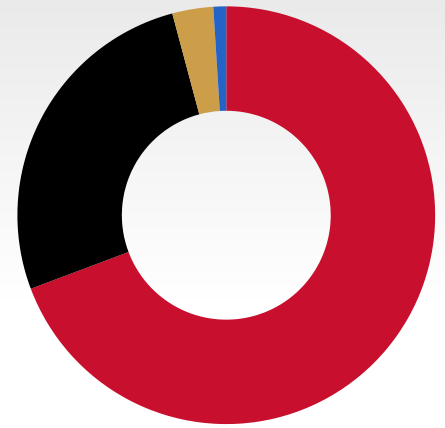

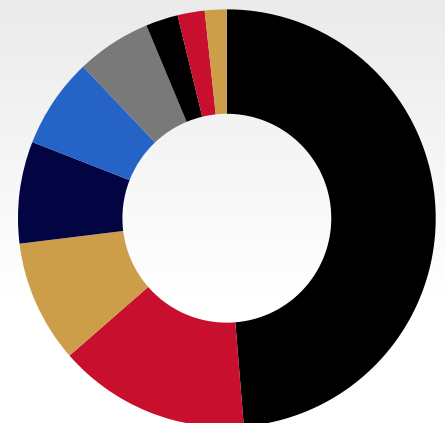
Average salary for the Class of 2025 (excluding bonuses)

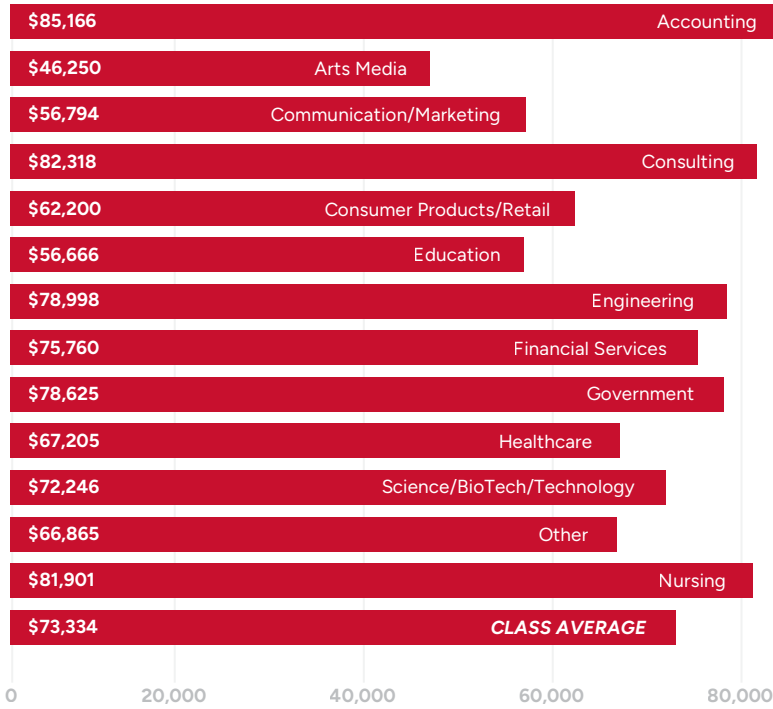

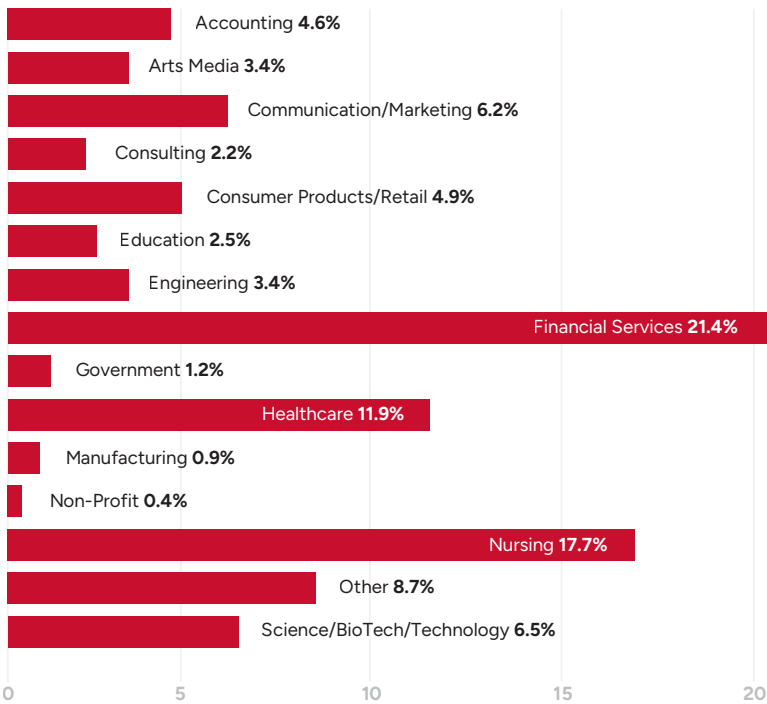
