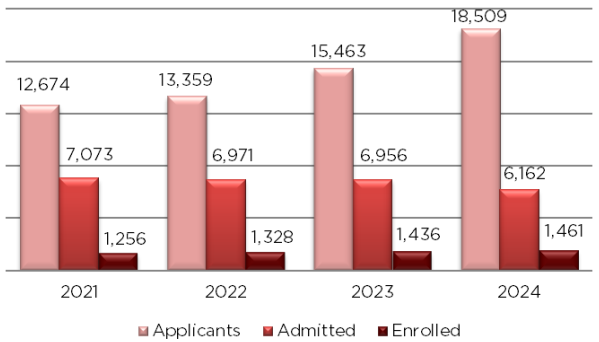

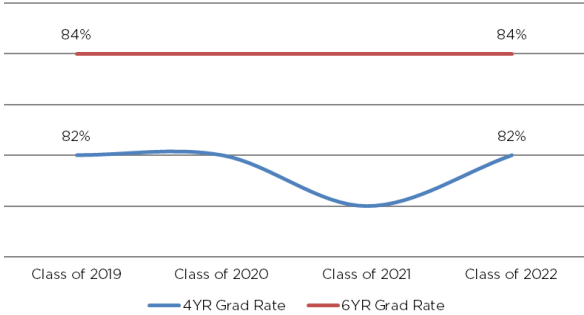

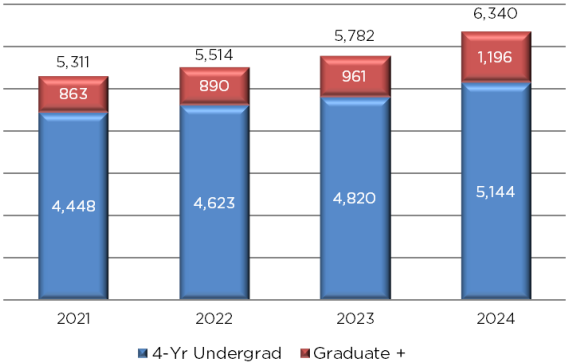

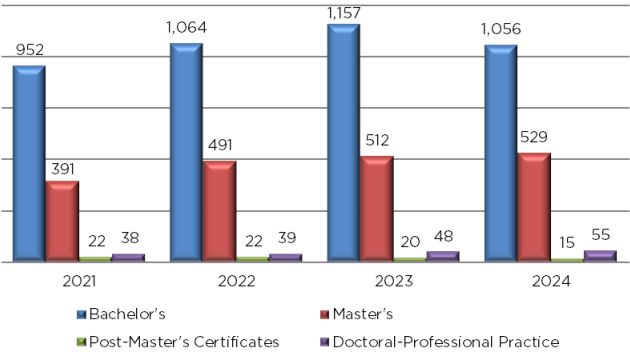

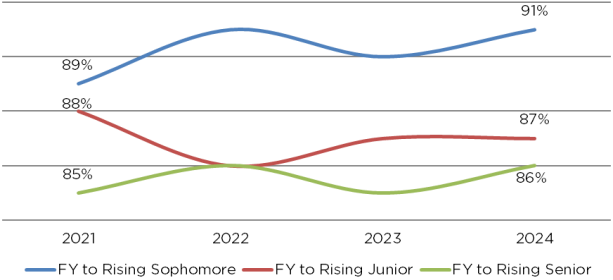

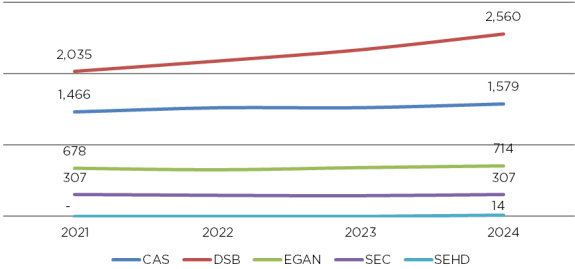


RETENTION RATES

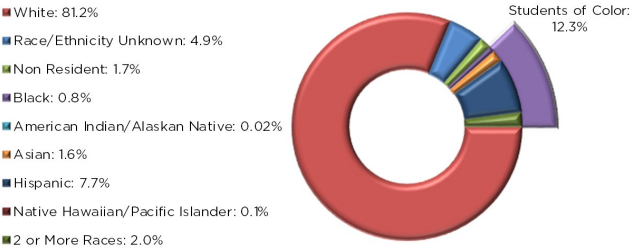


ENROLLMENT BY COLLEGE

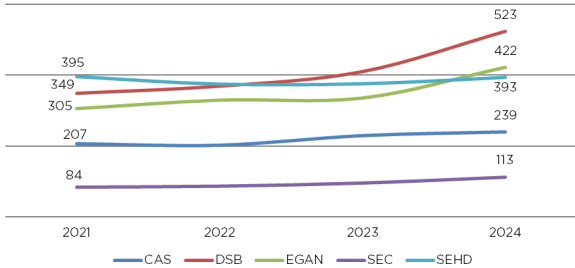
