

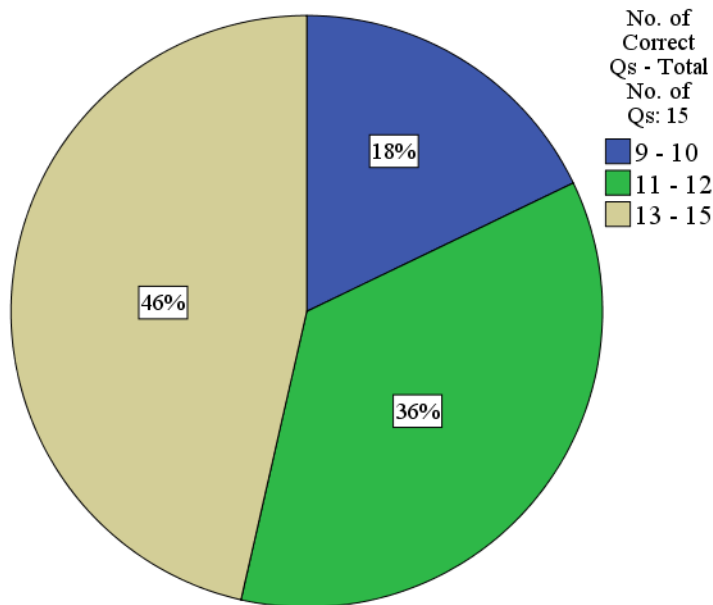
## Department of Sociology & Anthropology – Assessment

The Department's assessment plan includes an exit survey conducted, each spring, in SO 222 Research Methods, a required course for all majors. Most of the students are seniors who have completed a minimum of 10 ten course, including 5 required courses: Introduction, Classical Theory, Contemporary Theory, Data Analysis and Research Methods.

The assessment survey includes 15 questions which reflected the **Knowledge** and **Skill** goals defined in the Department's **Assessment Plan** (rev. April 2012).

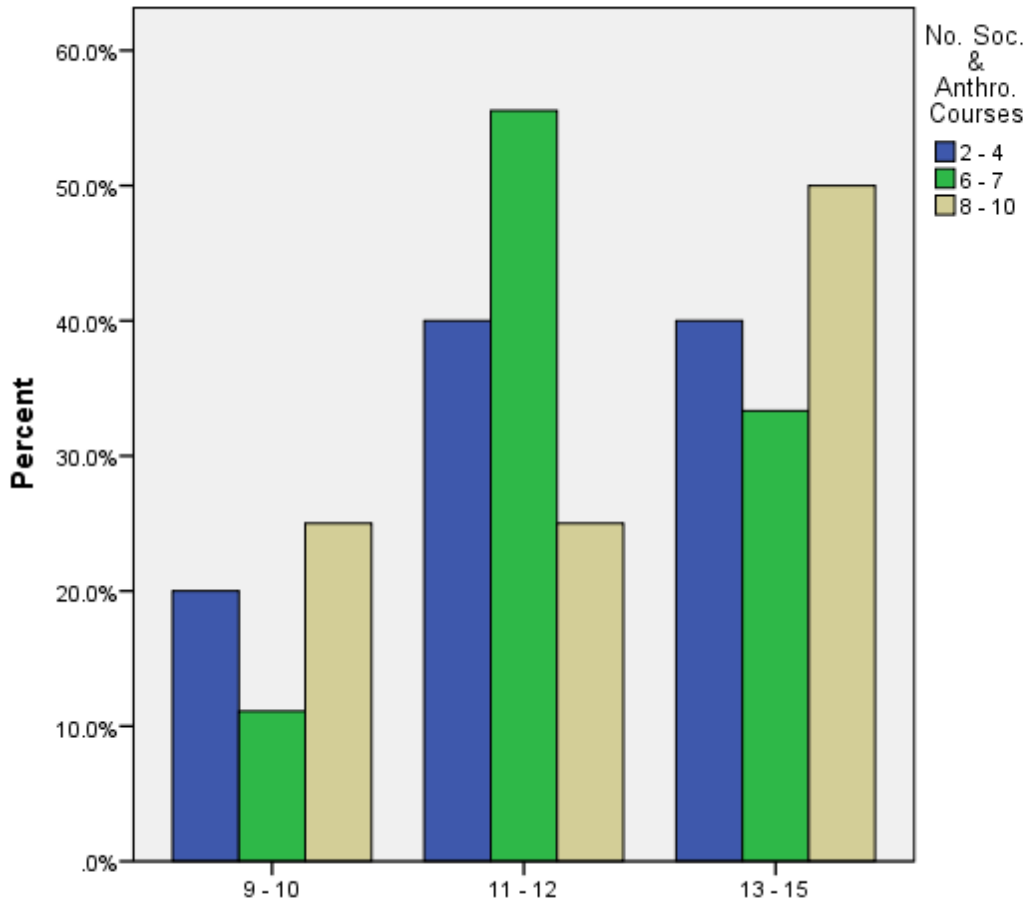
A total of 28 students completed the survey: 15 in Spring 2015 - 16 in Spring 2016

Chart 1



- Overall 46% of the majors answered 13, 14 or 15 questions correctly
- 36% answered 11 or 12 questions correctly

Chart 2 - Number of Questions Answered Correctly



- Students who completed 8 to 10 courses were more likely to answer the survey questions correctly.

The Assessment Survey's 15 questions are organized into two rubrics: **Knowledge Goals** and **Skill Goals**
