Fairfield University appreciates the cooperation and courtesy shown by students, employees, and visitors who observe established parking and traffic regulations. All persons operating a motor vehicle on campus roads should recognize that Fairfield University is a pedestrian community. Please exercise extreme caution while driving on campus. Campus speed limit is 20mph.

All vehicles entering campus must be registered with the Department of Public Safety Parking Office at **fairfield.edu/parking**. All parking regulations are in effect 24/7, 365. Allocated parking areas are subject to change. **Student vehicles may only be parked in lots designated by permit type.** Please visit our website for updates on traffic regulations and policies.

On occasion, Public Safety will require vehicles to be moved due to weather/events. In those cases, vehicles should be returned to their designated lot by noon the following day.

Chronic parking/traffic offenders who accumulate five (5) violations for being unregistered will be subject to having their vehicles booted. Those <u>registered chronic offenders</u> who receive five (5) violations may be subject to modified parking. A \$60 surcharge will also be added to the regularly published fine schedule and the vehicle is subject to immobilization, tow and additional fees. Paying tickets does NOT remove them from the total count of violations. As a result, additional violations will result in subsequent tows, boots and fees. Individuals will not be pre-warned prior to booting/towing. All towing charges are the responsibility of the owner.

First year and sophomore residential students are not permitted to register vehicles. These vehicles parked on campus prior to approval, will be ticket, booted or towed. Junior and senior students who register a vehicle owned by an underclassman will lose their own parking privileges.

Motor vehicles may not be stored on campus without the written approval from the Public Safety. In addition, motor vehicles that do not have a valid state registration plate, are disabled, disassembled or inoperable, are not allowed on campus. These vehicles will be removed from campus under the direction of the Department of Public Safety, at the owner's expense.

Mopeds and motorcycles must adhere to University regulations as it pertains to motor vehicle registration, operation, and parking and may not be secured to trees, railings, posts, etc. (Violators will be ticketed and the vehicle impounded).

Fraudulent registration, misrepresentation of University affiliation, and the display of stolen, altered or counterfeit permits constitute grounds for disciplinary action, ticketing, booting, towing and addition fees.

All University/Prep students and employees are reminded that through a commitment to the town of Fairfield, no members of this community may park on neighboring streets. The University reserves the right to ticket as necessary.
