

FY17 Student Research Scholarship Funds

The following Scholars Programs support student research projects that illustrate a close collaboration with a faculty mentor. Priority will be given to projects with an articulated plan for dissemination and to support opportunities for students who otherwise would not be able to afford them. The Committee will review your application for one of the following scholarships:

- Arts and Sciences: CAS Scholarship, Mancini Scholarship, Lawrence Scholars
- Nursing: Lawrence Scholars
- Science: Femia Science Endowment
- History: Risica Family Fund
- All Majors: Corrigan Scholars, Hardiman Scholars, McGuinness Scholarship

A 2.80 GPA is the minimum requirement for this award. Applications will be accepted in three cycles. The deadlines are: September 30, February 15 and April 21. Awardees will be notified within 30 days after the deadline. Application must be completed by the student with all required attachments. Projects should be no longer than 15 months in duration. If the project lasts beyond the 15 months, a request for extension must be filed. Submissions will be reviewed by a committee appointed by the Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs. All applications must be sent to Dr. Mary Frances Malone, Canisius 300.

Required Attachments:

- 1) **Title and Description of Student's Research Project** (200 Words). Application must be readable to various disciplines
- 2) **Role of Faculty Mentor** (100 words)
- 3) **Anticipated Impact of Project on student's Academic/Professional Goals** (150 words)
- 4) **Plan to Disseminate Findings/Results:**
 - Research Project must be presented at the "Research and Creative Accomplishments Symposium" which is held on campus in late April each year.
- 5) **Detailed Budget – a one page budget narrative is required,**
 - Funds can be used to support work directly related to a students' research project (e.g., covering students' costs related to travel to research sites, travel/fees for conferences, research materials/supplies, summer housing on campus, travel costs related to for credit internships with a substantial faculty mentorship component)
- 6) **Letter of endorsement from faculty mentor**
- 7) **Attachment: Student's Resume (1 page maximum)**
 - Individual resumes are required for all team members
